RESOLUTION NO. 0114-2012

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ALASKA BOARD OF GAME AND THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH & GAME FOR AN EMERGENCY OPENING FOR CARIBOU HUNTING IN UNIT 9C NORTH OF THE ALASKA PENINSULA HIGHWAY NORTH AND WEST OF PAUL'S CREEK

WHEREAS: The King Salmon Village Council represents the tribal residents of the King Salmon, AK area, and

WHEREAS: The Mulchatna Caribou herd has migrated to the area of unit 9C, between the North Shore of the Naknek River and the Branch River, and

WHEREAS: The hunting of the Mulchatna Caribou do not pose a threat to the Northern Alaska Peninsula Caribou herd, because they are from the Mulchatna herd, and

WHEREAS: Residents of the area are in need of food, and the residents did not get a permit hunt last year, and

WHEREAS: With the extremely high price of towards six dollars per gallon of gasoline we should not have to drive by Caribou herds in their area to hunt elsewhere, and

WHEREAS: That the King Salmon Village Council requests the Alaska Board of Game and the State Of Alaska Department of Fish & Game to open the hunting of Caribou with the same big limit as the Alagnak River drainage, so that residents of the area can hunt the Mulchatna herd, which have migrated to the area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the King Salmon Village Council requests the Alaska Board of Game and the State of Alaska Department of Fish & Game to immediately address the issue before these Caribou move out of the area.
